The different brands and different jaw configurations

Rifeng – uses U Type Jaws

Aus Pex uses U Type Jaws

Kembla Uses Smooth Jaws

K1 & K2 Use Smooth Jaws

Pexal uses H Type jaws.

The types of heads are usually stamped on the jaws



Rothenberger Compact Tool – used by Kembla – has smooth Jaws and can be used K1 & K2 also – excluding 32mm – Reece have an exclusive agreement with Rothenberger and we are still waiting to see if we can buy heads. We may start to see some rothenbergers from the Reece stores

The Aus Pex system uses the same U Type Jaws as Rifeng



Our Mini with the U type heads– Some K1 & K2 and Kembla tools around- they have smooth Jaws.

There will be a few AKKU – large REMS Tools around probably mostly with Rifeng U Type heads – possibly Pexal H Type heads



Klauke Mini Tool – Mostly distributed by Crane in the early days of K1 & K2 when it was stainless steel crimp ring – the heads were U Type, When Crane introduced the copper crimp the jaws were machined smooth. We have u type heads on the way to convert K1 & K2 users.
